Knowledge mobilization captures the concepts and practices that optimize the knowledge and creativity produced in an educational setting. It enriches the sciences, arts, industry and cultural discourse, and marks the link between research and change and between the academy and the publics it serves.

Eligibility: Currently-enrolled master's or doctoral students, and current post-doctoral scholars.

Awards: Research and/or travel funds will be bestowed as follows: \$250 award for one master's student, \$500 for one doctoral students and \$800 for one post-doctoral scholar.
